Admission Policy as determined by the Governing Body

1. Relevant legislation and regulations pertaining to the admission to Kloof Junior Primary School are contained in the following documents
 - 1.1 The South African Schools Act. Act 84,1996.
 - 1.2 The Constitution of the Republic of South Africa Act 108,1996, (Section 29).
 - 1.3 The National Education Policy Act 27/1996
 - 1.4 Education Laws Amendment Act No 50, of 2002
 - 1.5 Provincial Acts
 - 1.6 Promotion of Administrative Act (Act 3/2000)
 - 1.7 Health and Safety Acts
 - 1.8 Norms and Standards of funding
 - 1.9 Judgments of the Constitutional Court on Powers and duties of Governing Bodies.
2. All parents applying for a position at Kloof Junior Primary must ensure that their child is age appropriate.
3. Kloof Junior Primary School shall admit learners and serve their educational requirements without unfair discrimination.
4. The Admissions Committee of the Governing Body shall evaluate the application for admission of a learner within the legal framework of national, provincial and school policies.
5. The Governing Body shall exercise its right to declare Kloof Junior Primary a fee paying school, prepare a budget and set the number of learners who can be accommodated at the school.
6. The Governing Body has determined that the school shall be a single medium school and that the language of instruction shall be English.
7. When selecting learners the following procedure is followed:-
 - 7.1 First Selection - siblings of learners already at Kloof Junior Primary
 - 7.2 Second Selection - learners who live in the Kloof Junior Primary feeder area where Kloof Junior Primary is the nearest Primary School to their place of residence
 - 7.3 Third Selection - parents who work in the Kloof Junior Primary feeder area where Kloof Junior Primary is the nearest Primary School to their place of work.
 - 7.4 Fourth Selection – other relevant factors.
8. The Principal reserves the right to interview both the parents and the learners referred to in paragraph 7 above, when any application is made for a position at Kloof Junior Primary School.
9. Parents applying for admission to Kloof Junior Primary School shall do so by not later than the 9th day of June of the year preceding the year in which the learner is to be admitted. Should the number of learners who can be accommodated at the school (as set by the Governing Body in paragraph 5 supra) not be reached, applications filed after the 9th June of the year preceding the year in which the learner is to be admitted may be considered by the admissions committee of the Governing Body.
10. Incomplete forms shall not be processed irrespective of when they were received.
11. Applicants shall be informed in writing by the Principal of the outcome of their application.
